ANGELS ON THE ATLANTIC WELCOMES RECORD NUMBER OF YOUTH PARTICIPANTS SINCE INCEPTION OF PROGRAM

OCEAN CITY, NJ—August 12, 2008—Angels on the Atlantic, a non-profit organization for underserved, inner-city youth that delivers a variety of fun beachside educational and recreational activities at its beachfront location in Ocean City, N.J., will host more than 1,600 visitors this August - its largest number of monthly participants since the program began in 2005.

This hands-on organization has seen record growth over the past three summers, including the addition of four new "By the Sea" programs: Science, Arts & Entertainment, Health & Nutrition, and Sports & Fitness. Groups from Caring People Alliance, the Police Athletic League, and local recreation centers will participate in these and other activities before the summer comes to a close.

"Ocean City is a wonderful family destination that every child should get to experience," said Jeanie Wechsler-Hubach, Co-Founder and CEO, Angels on the Atlantic. "We are thrilled by the success of a program that makes this possible for inner city youth and we hope that these children can someday bring their families here and continue this special tradition."

The program, designed for children ages 7 to 15, includes complimentary beach access, beach tags, t-shirts, games, educational activities, keepsakes, refreshments and lunch. Offerings include a diverse range of programs and activities on a rotated calendar basis, ensuring a fresh experience for even the most frequent visitors.
